## Propoxur (Baygon)

Acute oral exposure of humans to propoxur leads to cholinesterase inhibition of red blood cells, with mild cholinergic symptoms that include blurred vision, nausea, vomiting, sweating, and tachycardia; however, the effects are transient (1,3,4) Cholinesterase depression has also been observed in rats acutely exposed by ingestion (3)

Bed Bugs: Reddish brown, flattened and oval in shape; about 1/5 inch long; short thick antennae; dark protruding eyes and wing-like structures on either side of the head; Immature bed bugs are similar to adult, about the size of a poppy seed and yellowish-white in color
