Small numbers of minimally pathogenic skin commensals (ie, coagulase negative staphylococci) likely represent contamination For samples collected via catheter, bacterial counts $\geq 10^4$ CFU/mL in males and $\geq 10^5$ in females are typically considered significant Samples with lower counts should be interpreted with caution and ideally repeated
