The vast majority of these first-generation movie theaters have been demolished or remodeled for other purposes One that remains is the Biograph Theater, constructed in 1914 (designated a Chicago Landmark in 2001) By the 1920s, Chicago was "the jumpingest movie city in the world and had more plush elegant theatres than anywhere else,"
