disability, quality of life, and functional outcomes after physical therapy interventions Pooling criteria were met by 84 RCTs that provided evidence for 12 physical therapy interventions on pain (n = 58), physical function (n = 36), and disability (n = 29) Most studies reported physical therapy effects at followups of 3 months or less

Dosage Considerations: Recommending School-Based ...

Intermittent A low dosage of physical therapy intervention provided irregularly or when needed over an episode of care Length of therapy session may vary For example, 2 to 5x/year for a total of 60 minutes Periodic A lower dosage of physical therapy intervention provided at regularly scheduled
