Management of cleft lip and palate 1 Figure I Submucous cleft palate missed or diagnosed late Nasal regurgitation of fluids may alert the paediatrician Cleft size of itself is not necessarily correlated with the extent of dysfunction Indeed some physically small clefts of the palate and submucous cleft palate may have serious implications for speech function and hearing

### **Cleft Lip Repair Post-Operative Instructions**

What is Cleft Lip Repair? The cleft of the lip can affect the right or left side (unilateral) or both sides (bilateral) In the cleft lip operation, incisions are made and the separate portions of the lip are brought together to form a single full lip The repair of the child's lip generally takes place at age 3-5 months, although optimum

### **PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEFT PALATE SURGERY**

(called secondary palatal management) may be necessary Stunting of Facial Growth: Any surgery performed on a growing child has the potential to create scar tissue that limits the potential growth in that area This is especially true with cleft lip and palate surgery,

### **ORTHODONTIC MANAGEMENT OF CLEFT LIP AND PALATE: ...**

Cleft Lip and Palate management vary in cleft centres across the world with the underlying philosophy being the same Early rehabilitation of the child allowing for normal development of intermaxillary relationship Integration of services The care of cleft lip and palate patients require a number of specialists including
