Sidewalks Wheelchairs require a 09-meter (3-feet) minimum clearance width for continuous passage, so side-walks should have a minimum clearance width of at least 15 meters (5 feet) They should be paved with a smooth, durable material Sidewalks should be built and ...

Chapter 105 STREETS AND SIDEWALKS ARTICLE I General ...

Pedestrian Design Guidelines - Portland, Oregon

Passage of the ADA marked a new era of responsibility for both public and private agencies, who must ensure that all users have access to all services and facilities The guidelines for the ADA include the minimum dimensions required to achieve that access In many cases, the guidelines in the Pedestrian Design Guide go beyond the minimum

RIGHT-OF-WAY FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Right-of-Way is the term used to describe "right of passage" over another's land When the Commonwealth acquires land for transportation purposes, it is actually obtaining a "right of passage" over the land on which a public road ultimately will be built It is a Constitutional right of the Commonwealth to acquire land for public purposes
