Muscular System Major components: 1 Skeletal Muscle- Voluntary muscles that attach to bone for movement 2 Smooth Muscle- Involuntary muscle found in major body systems that pushes contents through organs (Ex Stomach, blood vessels, etc) 3 Cardiac Muscle-Involuntary muscle of the heart and circulatory system that allows heart to pump blood

THE HUMAN BODY SYSTEMS The Skeletal System - The skeletal system is made of bones, cartilage and ligaments - The skeletal system has five major functions: - Provides your body with support and shape - Many bones give your body the shape you are familiar with The central part of your skeleton is your vertebral column, or spine

#### THE HUMAN BODY: SYSTEMS AT WORK SKELETAL SYSTEM: ...

Two vital functions of the skeletal system are to support the soft tissues of the body so the body can maintain its form and posture, and to protect the delicate structures like the brain, spinal chord, heart, lungs, and major blood vessels in the thoracic cavity

create highly detailed images of structures in the body Images are viewed as cross sections of the body part being scanned • Computed Tomography (CT) scan or a CAT scan -sophisticated, powerful x-ray that takes 360-degree pictures of internal organs, the spine and vertebrae

SKELETAL SYSTEM PRIMARY PURPOSE: gives body Shape, Support, Protection PRIMARY ORGANS: Bones (skull, ribs, vertebrae, femur, pelvis, etc) (1) Protects most internal organs (that are soft and vulnerable) (2) Provides movement for the body together with Muscles
